





Cooperation with Germany












- University ranking (QS or CHE University Ranking).
- Some German universities do not actively participate in university rankings.





Choosing a University, cont...





- Universities- good for scientifically-oriented education.
- Offer broad range of courses and subjects
- For the doctoral degrees-> recommend-> Universities



- Universities of applied sciences- good for practice-oriented education
- Provides scientifically based education, tailored to demands of professional life
- Generally include internships

• DAAD (check DAAD website to choose the correct funding programme and the deadlines, contact the regional office for more clarifications).




 Check the requirements – submit the required document, pay the semester fee, and contact international student office.















Academic


- Discuss **expectations** at the beginning.


